- The contestant will be assigned to the age division according to the contestant's age on September 1, 2024.
- Adjustments are possible due to numbers per division.
- One crown (3"-6" depending on age group) and sash per division for king/queen.
- A minimum of 5 "Extra" awards will be given based on judges' decisions. Possible examples include eyes, outfit, personality.
- "People's Choice" tickets will be sold during the pageant for \$1 per vote. A special award will be given for the People's Choice award winner.
- A medallion will serve as the pumpkin patch pass for each contestant. Each contestant is allowed 1 Pumpkin Patch entrance with each paid pageant entry any date we are open to the public.
- **Dress is Fall Attire- There's always a great variety. Allow your contestant to wear what he/she is most comfortable wearing. Some ideas over the years-bell bottom pants, rompers, ruffle pants, denim, smocked/themed dress, pumpkins, etc. See photos from past pageants on our Facebook page.**
- Make-up should be age appropriate /natural.
- Basic modeling, no glitz.
- Pageant admission is \$5.00 per person (contestants are free). **Pageant will be our only event. Pumpkin Patch events will not be open. Playground will be open.**
- **Optional Practice-** Wednesday, September 25th at 4:00-5:30 pm.
- Saturday, September 28th. PAGEANT at 5:00 pm- Contestants must be backstage (in our classroom) by 4:00 and all remaining tickets are due by 4:30 pm.
- The contestant that sells the most pre-sale tickets will win the title of Hospitality and will receive a special award.
- If someone purchases tickets online, place the child's name in the notes section or contestant will need to keep a list of the purchaser(s) name and number of tickets purchased and turn in to us by 4:30 on pageant day.
- Each contestant may get entry tickets the day of practice to presale before the day of the pageant. Tickets are \$5 each. Online ticket sales count and are available now:

Day of Pageant

- Arrive to Middleton Farms by 4:00 p.m.
- You may practice on stage when you arrive. We just ask that everyone be in the classroom by 4:30.
- Contestants may dress in our restrooms or classrooms, but I recommend being dressed by 4:15.
- Contestants must be in our classroom by 4:30 to receive a contestant number.
- Once receiving number, contestants should only leave classroom to use the restroom.
- Contestants will be put in line order at 4:50 to walk in a single file line to begin the pageant.
- The first age groups will be lined up behind the stage.
- Contestants will be in chairs to the left of the stage in order.
- One adult per contestant in classroom due to space and noise level.
- One adult may walk on stage for children 3 and under.
- Concessions will be sold such as sodas, nachos, and roasted corn.
